



He obtained his MA in International Relations, from the University of Colombo in 1998. He is also a Hepatologist in the Colombo North Hepatobiliary and Liver Transplant Service, Ragama. He is a board certified trainer in Gastroenterology and a long term member of the Specialty Board of study in Gastroenterology, Post-graduate institute of Medicine, University of Colombo. He graduated from the University of Colombo and had his post graduate training in intestinal and liver disease from the Professorial Medical Unit, Ragama and the Addenbrooke's Hospital, Cambridge, UK. His research interests in Liver diseases include non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD), cirrhosis and its complications, hepatocellular carcinoma and liver transplantation. His luminal research interests include inflammatory bowel disease, tropical gastroenterology and endoscopic techniques.

He has presented many research abstracts at international scientific gatherings such as Digestive Diseases Week (DDW) and United European Gastroenterology Week (UEGW) and authored many papers on above subjects in high impact, indexed, peer reviewed journals. He has also won many awards related to the research presented in his field of interests both nationally and internationally.

Prof. U.S. Amarasinghe Department of Zoology and |Environmental Management

Professor Upali S. Amarasinghe's research career commenced in 1980 when he started research on limnology of major perennial reservoirs of Sri Lanka. His research was aimed at developing suitable management strategies for the fisheries in reservoirs of Sri Lanka. So far, he has published over 150 research papers, edited 10 monographs presented over 75 scientific communications in international and national conferences. He serves as a member of the editorial boards of several scientific journals Asian Fisheries Science, Taprobanica - The Journal of Asian Biodiversity, and as an honorary editor of Sri Lanka Journal of Aquatic Sciences. He also served as a member of editorial board of the Journal of National Science Foundation.

In July 2010, he was awarded Doctor of Science (D.Sc.) by Bangor University, U.K., for his research on the management of tropical artisanal fisheries.

He was a member of the working party of experts on inland fisheries in the Indo-Pacific Fisheries Commission of Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations. He also served as an international consultant to the International Development Research Centre, Canada (IDRC), to the University of Stirling, UK, to the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) and to the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO). Professor Amarasinghe also served as a consultant to the Network of Aquaculture Centres in Asian-Pacific (NACA) in Bangkok, Thailand.

His research findings have a high positive impact on inland fisheries of Sri Lanka because they were adopted by the government for defining management strategies. Under the Fisheries and Aquatic Resources Act of 1996, several inland fisheries regulations have been formulated and implemented, based on his research findings.

He was instrumental to obtain two major research grants for collaborative research projects from the European Union and Australian Centre for International Agricultural Research. Through these projects, he has trained several postgraduate students.

Hitherto, he has trained 36 postgraduates. They include 08 Ph.D. degrees, 14 M.Phil. degrees and 14 M.Sc. degrees. Presently 05 postgraduate students carry out research under his supervision.

He won several national and international awards for his research. They include the prize for the best young scientist in biology for his research on inland fisheries awarded by the Third World Academy of Sciences (TWAS), Committee of Vice Chancellors and Directors (CVCD) excellence award in 2008 for the most outstanding scientist in biological sciences, GRC Award in 2009 for the most outstanding scientist in biological sciences awarded by Sri Lanka Association for Advancement of Science. He received Presidential awards for the authorship of scientific papers figuring in Science Citation Index. In 2000, he was awarded a Commonwealth Postdoctoral Fellowship to work as a visiting academic at the Imperial College of Science, Technology and Medicine, University of London. He was also an academic visitor in the Netherlands Institute of Ecology in 2007. He is a Chartered Biologist of the Institute of Biology of Sri Lanka and a Fellow of National Academy of Sciences of Sri Lanka.

During 2018, he has published 09 research papers in indexed journals and 02 book chapters. According to Google Scholar Citations, Professor Amarasinghe h-index is 24 and upto now, there are 1817 citations of his research. The i10-index of Professor Amarasinghe is 51.

She has trained 11 postgraduates that includes 1 Ph.D., 3 M.Phil. & 7 M.Sc. degrees. Her current research work mainly focuses on fabrication of photovoltaic materials and devices for solar energy applications.

In 2018, she has produced 5 research papers in indexed international journals having the impact factor above 2, a local peer reviewed journal article and a book chapter. She has been working as a reviewer in number of prestigious international journals publish by Springer and Elsevier viz; Ceramic International, Journal of Alloys and Compounds, Journal of Materials Chemistry and Physics, Journal of Materials Science: Materials in Electronics and Journal of Photochemistry and Photobiology A: Chemistry.

After obtaining her PhD, she joined the academic staff of the Department of Chemistry, University of Kelaniya as a Senior Lecturer (II) in 2011. Her field of expertise is Medicinal Inorganic Chemistry with special focus on synthesis of ruthenium (II)-aminoquinoline complexes and metal-free aminoquinolines for chemotherapy of malaria and cancer, the evaluation of their biological activity, and the study of their mechanisms of action. RP involved research and education in the lines of Environmental Archaeology and Quaternary Palaeo-ecology and Climate Change Science in South and Southeast Asia since 1995, including Teaching, Fieldwork, Laboratory experiments, Excavations, Surveys, and Research Administration in attending more than 50 International Conferences. RP engaged the programs and activities conducted by INQUA-HaBcom (International Union for Quaternary Research-Human and Biosphere Commission). Mrs. M.K.D. Padmasiri




Dr. D.S.G. Mettananda

# **5.3.1. Faculty of Medicine**



Dr. W.M.M.L. Chandradasa

Dr W. M. M. L. Chandradasa is currently attached as a lecturer to the Department of Psychiatry, Faculty of Medicine of the University of Kelaniya Sri Lanka. For the last two years, he has been in Australia working as an advanced trainee Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist at the Latrobe Hospital and Senior Honorary Lecturer of the Faculty of Medicine Nursing and Health Sciences of the Monash University Australia. He has now completed his post-doctoral advanced training in child and adolescent psychiatry and is expected to obtain the board certification. Once this is completed in the near future, Dr Chandradasa would be the first board certified Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist attached to the University of Kelaniya Sri Lanka. Child and adolescent psychiatry is a medical speciality that involves the assessment and management of psychological and learning issues of children and youth.

Dr Chandradasa obtained the qualification of Doctor of Medicine in Psychiatry from the Postgraduate Institute of Medicine in Sri Lanka in 2015 (MD Psychiatry), Member of the Royal College of Psychiatrists in the United Kingdom in 2018 (MRCPsych) and Advanced Certificate in Child and Adolescent Psychiatry from the University of Melbourne in Australia in 2018 (Child Psych AdvCert).

Dr Chandradasa is interested and conducts research in developmental psychiatry, transcultural psychiatry and child mental health. During the year 2018, he has published 16 peer-reviewed full articles in journals including 13 PubMed indexed publications. The publications were on research topics such as psychological morbidity of dengue fever, the influence of Buddhism in Western psychotherapeutic practices, presentations of reincarnation associated with autism, the mental health impact of social discrimination of young women and sexual minorities and near-death experiences of hospitalized patients in Sri Lanka.

His ongoing research projects include collaborations with Australia on speech variations in depressive disorder, with the United Kingdom on twin studies in autism spectrum disorder and with Canada on character development of adolescents in Sri Lanka.

## **5.3.2 Faculty of Science**

Professor Upali S. Amarasinghe's research career commenced in 1980 when he started research on limnology of major perennial reservoirs of Sri Lanka. He was a member of the working party of experts on inland fisheries in the Indo-Pacific Fisheries Commission of Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations. He also served as an international consultant to the International Development Research Centre, Canada (IDRC), to the University of Stirling, UK, to the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) and to the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO). Professor Amarasinghe also served as a consultant to the Network of Aquaculture Centres in Asian-Pacific (NACA) in Bangkok, Thailand.


His research findings have a high positive impact on inland fisheries of Sri Lanka because they were adopted by the government for defining management strategies. Under the Fisheries and Aquatic Resources Act of 1996, several inland fisheries regulations have been formulated and implemented, based on his research findings.

He was instrumental to obtain two major research grants for collaborative research projects from the European Union and Australian Centre for International Agricultural Research. Through these projects, he has trained several postgraduate students.

Hitherto, he has trained 36 postgraduates. They include 08 Ph.D. degrees, 14 M.Phil. degrees and 14 M.Sc. degrees. Presently 05 postgraduate students carry out research under his supervision.

He won several national and international awards for his research. They include the prize for the best young scientist in biology for his research on inland fisheries awarded by the Third World Academy of Sciences (TWAS), Committee of Vice Chancellors and Directors (CVCD) excellence award in 2008 for the most outstanding scientist in biological sciences, GRC Award in 2009 for the most outstanding scientist in biological sciences awarded by Sri Lanka Association for Advancement of Science. He received Presidential awards for the authorship of scientific papers figuring in Science Citation Index. In 2000, he was awarded a Commonwealth Postdoctoral Fellowship to work as a visiting academic at the Imperial College of Science, Technology and Medicine, University of London. He was also an academic visitor in the Netherlands Institute of Ecology in 2007. He is a Chartered Biologist of the Institute of Biology of Sri Lanka and a Fellow of National Academy of Sciences of Sri Lanka.

During 2018, he has published 09 research papers in indexed journals and 02 book chapters. According to Google Scholar Citations, Professor Amarasinghe h-index is 24 and upto now, there are 1817 citations of his research. The i10-index of Professor Amarasinghe is 51.

Prof Liyanage has receive many research grants form local and international agencies including IAEA, NRC, NSF, CARP, Ministry of Mahaweli Development and Environment, UNDP, DMC, IWMI and she was a main researcher in the National Research Program for Chronic Kidney Disease of unknown aetiology (CKDu) coordinated and funded by the WHO. She has involved in conducting multy-disciplinary research on CKDu in order to find out the causative factors for the disease for many years.

In 2018 Prof Liyanage has received a grant worth of 150 Million to establish a Research and Information Center for Chronic Kidney Disease of unknown Etiology at the University of Kelaniya from the Presidential Task force for prevention of Chronic Kidney Disease.
