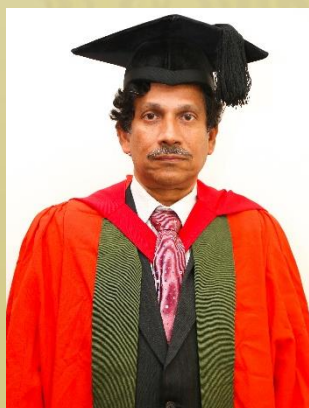

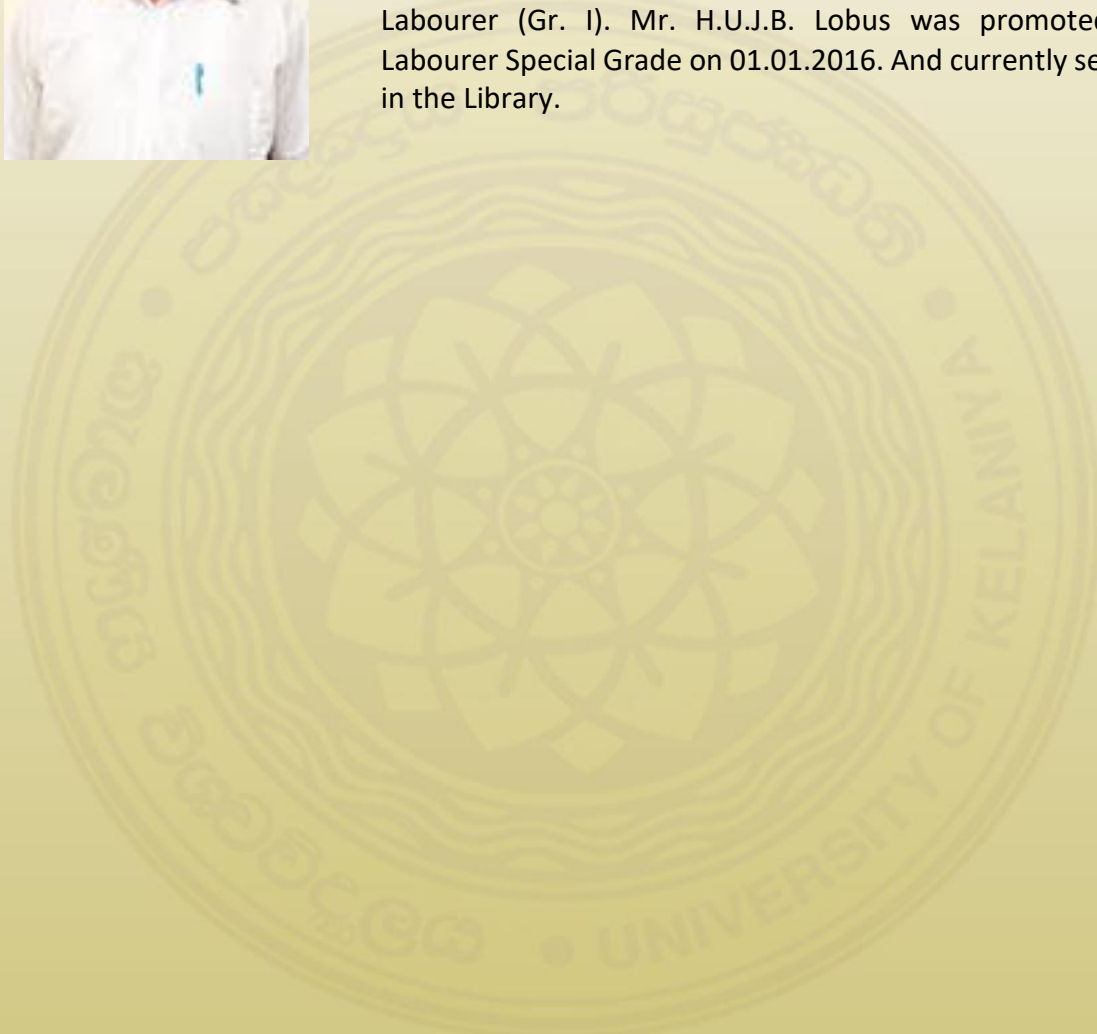

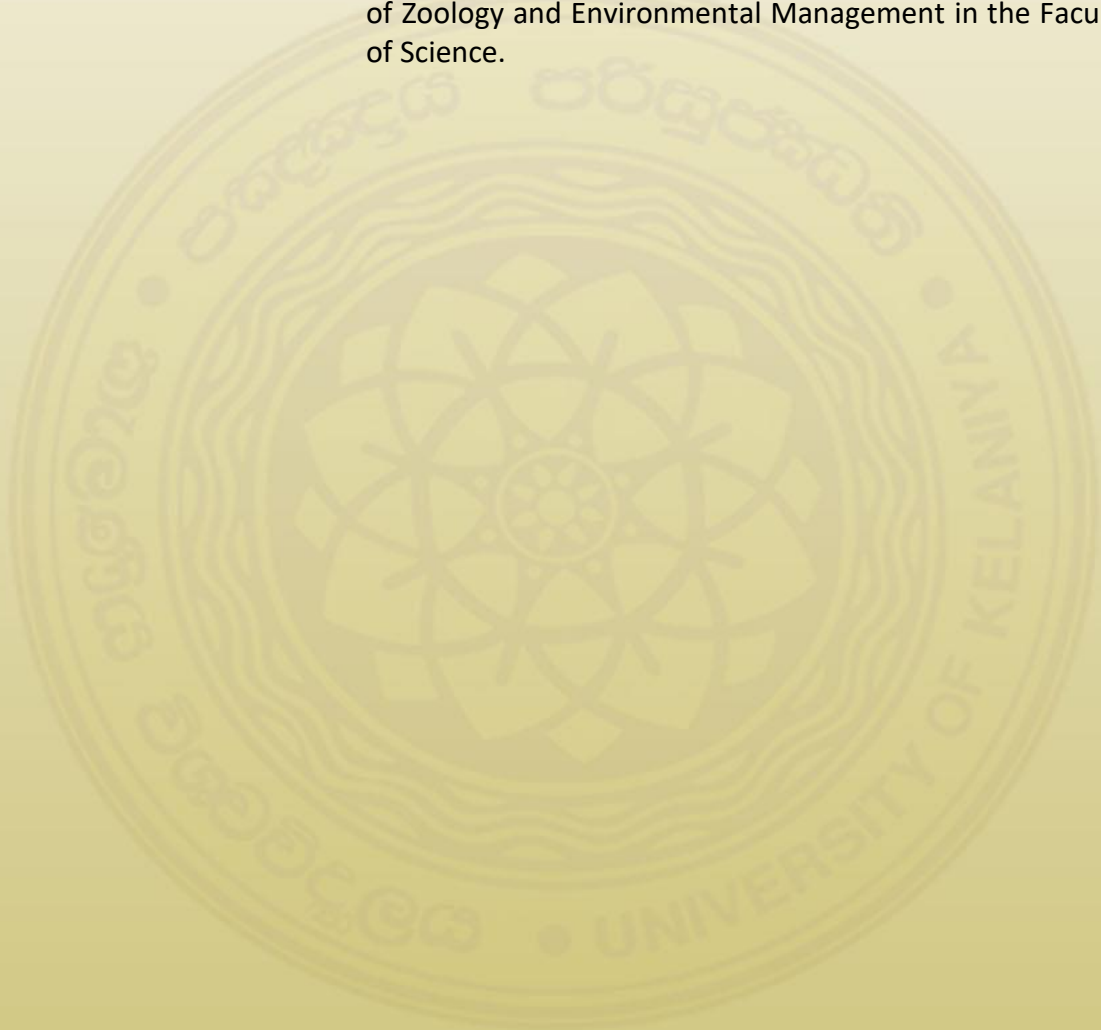

Dileepa won the Commonwealth Split-site PhD Scholarship to continue his PhD research at the Lancaster University, United Kingdom. His PhD research involves evaluating the spatiotemporal patterns and the effects of global climate change on the neglected tropical diseases and through this, he developed snakebite and soil-transmitted helminths risk maps for Sri Lanka. His PhD research on snakebite has been awarded three President's Awards for Scientific Publications, and his work on soil-transmitted helminths contributed to change the national deworming guidelines in Sri Lanka and was recognized as a highly commended article at the Taylor & Francis Commonwealth Scholar Best Journal Article Prize 2020.

As a child psychiatrist, he has won numerous senate and vice-chancellor awards for his research related to child mental health in Sri Lanka.

Dr. Chandradasa is interested and conducts research in character development, transcultural psychiatry and child mental health. During the last 5 years (2016 – 2020), he has published 48 full papers in peer-reviewed journals including 26 PubMed indexed publications. Social protection is important for the present world where there are many prevailing socio economic issues such as poverty, hunger, income inequality, high unemployment rate and seasonal and unexpected pandemics like COVID-19. Considering the severity of these socio-economic issues, UN declare Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) which targets to overcome these issues by 2030. Some of these goals are zero poverty, no hunger, higher economic growth and decent work. To achieve these sustainable development goals by 2030, social protection may play a vital role.

An outstanding research team from the Faculty of Social Sciences who study this link between social protection and sustainable development goals in Sri Lanka received LKR 10 million from the Accelerating Higher Education Expansion and Development (AHEAD) operations (DOR HEMS Projects) of the Ministry of Higher Education, funded by the World Bank. This study is highly relevance to Sri Lanka, as the country is yet to be achieved important SDGs such as zero poverty, no hunger, decent work, stable economic

growth, despite the fact that some of the socio-economic indicators look decent and improved over the time. According to Google Scholar Citations, Professor Kularatne's h-index is 4 and up to now, there are 113 citations of his research. The i10-index of Professor Kularatne is 3.

Currently, she is investigating early molecular markers of disease severity in dengue, as well as the absorption of phenolic antioxidants by coconut oil in cellular and animal model systems.

During 2019-2020, Prof. Jayathilaka published several abstracts and four full papers in indexed journals, two of which were supported by a university (internal) research grant. 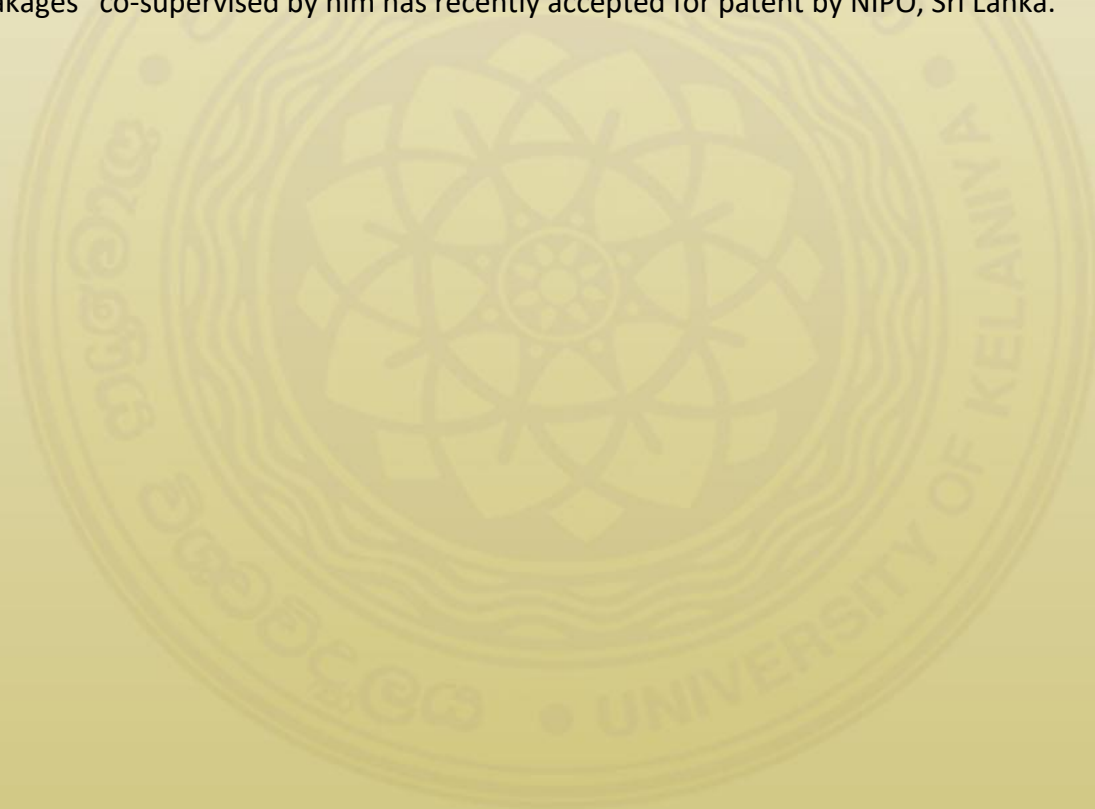

The prototype industrial design consists of a GSM module and microcontroller based auto removing regulator for LPG Cylinders and Bluetooth technology-based Electricity CUT-OFF system in the event of an accidental gas leakage.

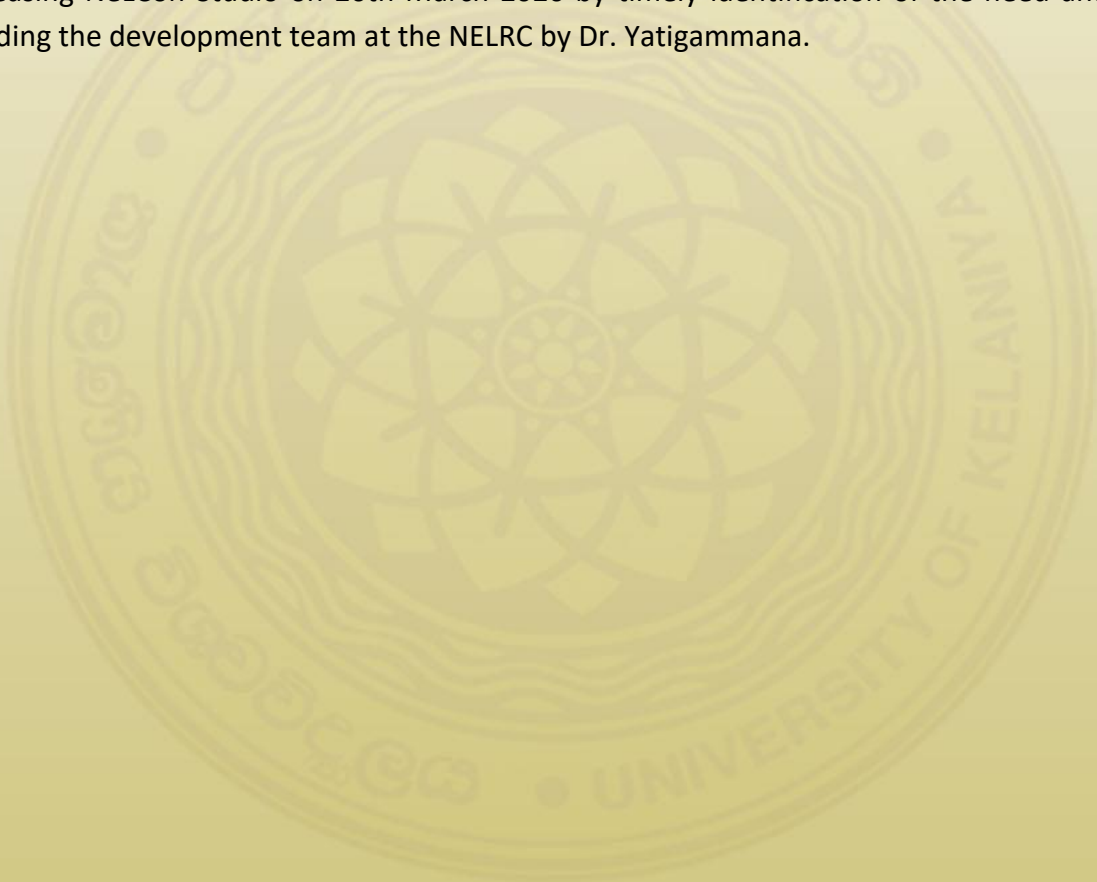

NeLCon Studio by National E-Learning Resource Center

The NeLCon Studio is the response of the National E-Learning Resource Center to the situation created by the Easter Sunday attack in April 2019. When the Covid-19 pandemic outbreak in March 2020, the initial version was ready for launch. NeLCon is capable of synchronized image transitions with the audio explanation. The ID3tag area has been used to embed multiple images and text into MP3 which has not been used for e-learning or other industries so far except the limited use in the music industry. NeLCon Studio makes the MP3 a Multimedia Learning Object for the first time in the world.
