At present, she is conducting research in formulating organic fertilizer and fungal bio control agents for sustainable agriculture. Prof. kannangara has contributed for the Department development of research by securing research grants from NSF, NRC, HETC and Ministry of Higher Education (multidisciplinary, multi-grantee project - SLR 12.6 million). Prof. Kannangara has supervised 10 post graduate (PhD and Mphil) students. She has published her research findings widely in indexed journals (47 full papers up to date) and presented her research nationally and internationally covering a broad range of topics including litter decomposition and forest soil nutrient dynamics, fungi (especially Trichoderma spp.) as bio control agents of pests, use of microorganisms in remediating environment pollutants (especially aromatic hydrocarbons) and formulation of organic fertilizer. Many new online projects for staff and students were commenced including Virtual Student Mobility for over 700 students from the Faculties of Humanities and Social Sciences in collaboration with Tallinn University, Estonia, Szczecin University, Poland, University of Siegen, Germany and Pozega Polytechnic, Croatia. A number of virtual events were organized by bringing many international partners on one platform including Erasmus Days 2021 University of Kelaniya on "Digital Transformation in Higher Education: Issues, Challenges and Sustainability", three virtual mobility projects with Tallinn University, one project with Szczecin University, Poland, finalizing six Erasmus+ Virtual Staff Mobility and initiating several joint research projects through Erasmus alumni, participation at the Alumni Academy "Digitalisation 20+ and Sustainability" 2021/2022 Blended Education - The Future Workshop" University of Siegen, Germany bringing students of three continents and four countries together for a digital cultural exchange experience, organizing virtual guest lectures and participation at virtual education fairs. Among the highlights of the contribution to International Affairs in 2021 is securing 43 new mobility grants for staff and students worth over 170,000 Euro for Erasmus+ incoming and outgoing mobility.



Prof. (Ms.) C. D. S. Wettewe Director Career Guidance Unit

Prof. Chamindi Dilkushi Senaratne Wettewe is a Professor attached to the Department of English Language Teaching at UOK. She obtained her PhD from the Radboud University, Nijmegen, in the Netherlands. She was Head of Department (2010-2014) and Director of Staff Development Centre (2014-2017). She joined the National Centre for Advanced Studies in the Social Sciences and Humanities (NCAS) in 2019 and served as the Senior Research Fellow till 2020.
