Prof. Seneviratne is also a Commonwealth Fellow at the University of Leeds, UK, and a Fulbright Fellow at the University of Massachusetts, Amherst, USA. His research interests are chemical and nutritional properties of edible oils and bioavailability of phenolic antioxidants. He has received the Esther and Stanley Kirschner Award from Wayne State University, USA, the Dr. C.L. de Silva Gold Medal Award from the Institute of Chemistry Ceylon, President's awards for scientific publications, SUSRED Awards from National Science Foundation, Sri Lanka, and Vice Chancellor Awards for Best Inventor 2020 and 2021, Researcher with Most Publications from Internal Grants 2021, Outstanding Senior Researcher Merit 2021 and Recipient of Highest Grants in the Faculty of Science 2020 for his research achievements.

Prof. Nimanthi Jayathilaka earned her B.Sc. (Honors) degree in Cell and Molecular Biology from University of Wisconsin, Superior, U.S.A in 2003 and earned her Ph. D. degree from the University of Southern California, U.S.A in Genetics, Molecular and Cell Biology in 2011. In December 2012, she joined University of Kelaniya, Sri Lanka as a senior lecturer in Chemistry and was promoted to the position of Professor in Molecular Biology and Biochemistry in 2016. Currently, she is developing a point-of-care isothermal amplification method for disease diagnosis and prognosis of severe dengue in resource limited settings. Further, her studies involve extending the shelf life of food products using phytoextracts and investigating the absorption of phenolic antioxidants by coconut oil in cellular and animal model systems.

During 2021-2022, Prof. Jayathilaka received two national patents for extending the oxidative and microbial shelf life of food products by application of thermostable phenolic antioxidants extracted from rice (*Oryza sativa*) bran and preserving the color of fruit or vegetable juices using coconut paring residue extract. The latter for which international patent application was also published under Patent Corporation Treaty (PCT) World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) for filing for "provisional protection" in other countries. Professor Jayawardena obtained her B.Sc. Honors degree from the University of Colombo and her Ph.D. from the University of Illinois at Chicago. Subsequently, she worked as a post-doctoral researcher at the College of Medicine, University of Kentucky, USA. During her tenure at the Department of Chemistry, University of Loughborough, U.K as a commonwealth scholar in 2010, she learned a novel technique to extract cinnamon bark oil using subcritical water which remarkably improved the quality of the extracted oil. After returning to Sri Lanka, she further improved the extraction technique to make it more economically viable and studied the antidiabetic properties of the extract extensively. She has developed a nutraceutical that is formulated using water-based Cinnamon extracts and a natural binder to capture the anti-diabetic properties of cinnamon. The nutraceutical supplement developed was accepted under the patent corporation treaty for filing. Professor Jayawardena's main research interests are in developing natural product-based nutraceuticals and formulating and promoting healthy lifestyles in communities. Currently, she is studying the effect of cinnamon nutraceuticals in improving the cardiac myopathy induced by renin angiotensin system. The research is funded through a Fulbright research scholar fellowship at the University of North Carolina, Chapel hill, USA. The laboratory she is attached to at University of North Carolina is highly acclaimed for developing animal models to study human diseases through genetic modifications. Professor Smithies was awarded the Nobel prize in Medicine and physiology in 2007.
