She holds a Doctor of Philosophy in Teaching Chinese as a Foreign Language (in Chinese Language), earned in 2017 from Central China Normal University in Wuhan, China. She also completed a Master of Arts in Linguistics & Applied Linguistics (in Chinese Language) in 2010 from the same institution, along with another Master's degree in Linguistics from the University of Kelaniya, Sri Lanka, in 2006. Additionally, she holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Kelaniya, Sri Lanka, completed in 2001, with a focus on Chinese Language, Japanese Language, and Linguistics.

Throughout her academic journey, Dr. Jani Samarakoon has been the recipient of several prestigious awards. She was honored with the Excellent Doctoral Dissertation Award for her exceptional doctoral dissertation at Central China Normal University in 2017. In recognition of her excellence in postgraduate studies, she was awarded the Chinese Government Scholarship for her studies from 2006 to 2010 and from 2014 to 2017. Furthermore, her Master's dissertation earned her the Excellent Student of the Language Research Institution Award in 2010.

Dr. Egodahage Jani Alwis Samarakoon has made significant contributions to the field of Applied Linguistics, particularly in comparative studies between Sinhala and Chinese languages, as well as in teaching Chinese as a foreign language.

Her talents also extend beyond the classroom, as she was awarded the First Prize in the Hubei Province Essay Competition, organized by the News Office of the People's Government of Hubei Province, China, in 2009. Dr. Jani Samarakoon's achievements are further underscored by her receipt of the Chinese Government Scholarship for her postgraduate studies from 2006 to 2010, highlighting her dedication and scholarly contributions.

Her primary, secondary, and high school education was at Visakha Vidyalaya, Colombo 5. She served as a prefect in high school and also participated in co-curricular activities such as Girl Guiding and was a member of the school's Western Band. She is also an active member of the Old Girls' Association of Visakha Vidyalaya.

She has been appointed as the Co-Director (for Sri Lanka) of the Confucius Institute (CI) at the University of Kelaniya since 2021. During this period, she organized many programs to enhance the relationship between China and Sri Lanka. These efforts have contributed to improving Chinese language knowledge among students in Sri Lanka. She has organized, cultural events, teacher training programs for Chinese language school teachers, Chinese language proficiency exams (HSK/HSKK), etc. During her HSK and HSKK Examination organization period, 10 Chinese testing centers in China and 66 foreign countries testing centers worldwide were awarded the title of "Excellent Testing Center for the Chinese Exam in 2021". It is a matter of pleasure and pride that the Confucius Institute of the University of Kelaniya has won this honor in Asia.

She organizes the Chinese Bridge competition, which is held every year for undergraduates studying Chinese language overseas. Under her organization, the University of Kelaniya undergraduates who study the Chinese language have won the overall championship every year. Scholarship programs are organized under her guidance for undergraduates and outsiders studying the Chinese language at the University of Kelaniya.

As the Co-Director (for Sri Lanka) of the CI at the University of Kelaniya, she coordinates the Certificate Course in Chinese Language, the Intermediate Certificate Course in Chinese Language, and the Advanced Certificate Course in Chinese Language. These courses are available not only to undergraduates from the University of Kelaniya but also to outsiders who are willing to study the Chinese language and culture.

During her tenure, she has made significant contributions to the Confucius Institute at the University of Kelaniya as the Co-Director (for Sri Lanka).

During 2023-2024, she received two Senate Awards for publishing research articles in indexed journals.



Professor Sudath Rajendra Deshapriya Kalingamudali is a Senior Professor in Electronics and the Dean of the Faculty of Science at the University of Kelaniya. He earned his Bachelor's Honours degree in Physics (1990) from the University of Kelaniya and completed his PhD in Electronic Engineering (1994) at the University of Sheffield under an Open Commonwealth Scholarship.

He has been awarded the prestigious Fulbright Fellowship twice, which is a rare achievement for an academic. He is a Chartered Scientist, Chartered Engineer, and Chartered Physicist, and holds fellowships with the Institution of Engineering and Technology (IET), the Institute of Physics (IOP), and the Institute of Physics Sri Lanka (IPSL).

Professor Kalingamudali has authored over 65 research papers, holds one Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) filling, eight Sri Lankan patents, and four industrial designs. Notably, eight of his patents and four industrial designs are currently being commercialised through nine licensing agreements.

He played a pivotal role in collaborating with OREL Corporation (Pvt) Ltd to license one of his innovative products, the "Remotely Controllable Regulator Connected in Series with Resistive and Inductive Loads", which was patented in 2019. The product was officially launched in April 2023.

This invention also earned a Bronze Medal in the Technical Field of Applied Sciences and Technology at the "Presidential Awards for Inventions – Years 2017 to 2020", held on 1 August 2024, at the BMICH under the patronage of His Excellency the President of Sri Lanka.

Notably, this is the first-ever Presidential Award for Inventions received by the University of Kelaniya in its 65-year history. Moreover, it marks the university's first innovation to be commercialised and successfully launched as a product.

Later, she joined the Faculty of Applied Sciences at Rajarata University of Sri Lanka as an Assistant Librarian, progressing to the position of Senior Assistant Librarian. In 2022, Dr. Harshani joined the University of Kelaniya as a Senior Lecturer in the Department of Library and Information Science, Faculty of Social Sciences. A committed scholar and advocate for community development, she has led various outreach programs, including training for preschool teachers, public librarians, and school librarians.

Her dedication to early childhood education is evident through her completion of a Diploma in Early Childhood Education and her active role as a resource person in preschool teacher training initiatives. Dr. Harshani honed her creative skills through story-writing training programs organized by Room to Read and the National Library and Documentation Board. In 2021, she published her storybook, "Senudigen Thaggak". The book was next translated into Tamil and English in 2023 and 2024, respectively. In 2024, the National Book Trust (NBT) of India included the Urdu translation of this book in its multilingual publishing efforts, promoting literacy and cultural diversity across the region.

Dr. Harshani also contributed as a member of the editorial board for the National Policy on Children's Books in Sri Lanka. This initiative, led by Room to Read Sri Lanka's National Consortium of Children's Books (NCCB) in partnership with the Ministry of Education, established a comprehensive framework titled "A Guide for Printed Books in the Digital Age". The policy aims to address the shortage of high-quality, culturally relevant children's literature by setting national standards for storybook creation, covering areas such as manuscript writing, illustration, design, and editing. It further integrates strategies for library development, teacher training, and community engagement to foster a strong reading culture among young learners. Through her multifaceted contributions, Dr. Harshani has significantly impacted the fields of library science, children's literature, and community education.

Cadre Chair and Senior Professor Prishanta Gunawardhana, from the Department of Archaeology at the University of Kelaniya, has been nominated for the prestigious title of Outstanding Promoter of International Relations in 2024 at the Vice Chancellor's Awards Ceremony. This honor, which he previously received in 2006, recognizes his extraordinary contributions to fostering international academic collaborations and advancing global research in multiple academic fields. In addition to this recent nomination, Professor Gunawardhana's ongoing commitment to excellence in research has been consistently acknowledged. He was recognized as the best researcher of the Faculty of Social Sciences at the University of Kelaniya during the Vice Chancellor's Awards Ceremony in 2007, 2008, and 2009, further cementing his reputation as a leading scholar in his field. At the State Literary Awards 2024, he was also awarded the Best Original Academic and Research Texts trophy for his influential book 'Low-Density Urbanism', which showcases his expertise in urban studies and his dedication to innovative, thought-provoking research.

Polonnaruwa Archaeological, Anthropological and Urban Landscape Project PAALUP was a collaborative research project that groundbreaking effort aimed at studying the historical, architectural, and sociocultural aspects of Sri Lanka's ancient urban centers, focusing on the city of Polonnaruwa. PAALUP was a product of a successful international collaboration spearheaded by the University of Kelaniya in Sri Lanka and the Department of Archaeology and History at La Trobe University, Australia.

This innovative project is focused on studying the historical, architectural, and socio-cultural aspects of Sri Lanka's ancient urban centers, particularly the city of Polonnaruwa. PAALUP was not just a bilateral initiative; it has expanded to include several prestigious academic institutions. This research has been successful due to the important contributions of the Postgraduate Institute of Archaeology and the University of Jaffna in Sri Lanka. A key component of the project was its annual workshop, which serves as a forum for archaeological practitioners to discuss the conservation and management strategies for Sri Lanka's ancient urban centers. The project encourages further research and dialogue on urbanization, with a particular focus on the legacy and preservation of ancient cities.

8.2.4. The Researcher with the Most Publications from University (Internal) Research Grants in the University

DSM De Silva has been a member of the Department of Chemistry, Faculty of Science at the University of Kelaniya since 1996. She earned her PhD in Engineering Materials from the University of Sheffield, UK, following her BSc from the University of Kelaniya. Prof. De Silva's research spans photovoltaic materials and devices for solar energy applications, biochar production for water purification, and the analysis of microplastics in environmental samples.

Her work in microplastic analysis initiated through a university research grant (RP/03/02/06/02/2021) has attracted substantial international funding, including a 76 million LKR grant from the Association of Commonwealth Universities (ACU) and 10 million LKR worth of grants from the Centre for Environment, Fisheries and Aquaculture Science (Cefas) under the Blue Planet Fund, UK. Prof. De Silva has made significant academic contributions, authoring five SCI-indexed journal publications and two referred non-indexed journal publications during the evaluation period.

Further, during the period of consideration, 1 PhD, 1 MPhil & 2 MSc research projects were completed under her supervision, and she is currently supervising 11-MPhils candidates. Her achievements were recognized at last year's Vice-Chancellor's Awards ceremony, where she was awarded for securing the highest external research funding and recognized as one of the top researchers in her faculty.
